The ABD Group Welfare and Development Association is a non-profit organization that, for more than 40 years, has been working to reduce inequalities and social and health vulnerability. Through a wide network of services and programs, we intervene in different areas of social action, such as drug addiction care, mental health, childhood, family, gender equality, dependency, aging, intellectual disability, poverty, social exclusion and the fight against climate change.

We are a benchmark in the third sector for our commitment to comprehensive and community care, effective management and the defense of social rights.

- → We celebrate the 30th anniversary of the CAMS program: A milestone in the support of people with HIV.
- → We face challenges such as the aging population, the digital divide of the elderly, child poverty and gender inequalities.
- → Cooltorise and Climate Ready Barcelona demonstrate how awareness and the use of technology are key to combating energy poverty and addressing climate change in a comprehensive way.

Diversification

- → We strengthen health and well-being promotion services and prevention of risky behaviors with the integration of the PDS Association.
- → We strengthen care services for victims of gender-based violence.
- → We are expanding the territorial coverage of child and family care services in Castile and León.

Permanent innovation

- → Catalonia Impacta Award for 'ATENEA': Recognized for its application of artificial intelligence for the care of the elderly.
- → Consolidation of 'La Botiga': Three years as a benchmark for the social transformation of free food distribution services.
- → We promote studies and projects that amplify the impact of interventions, such as the Care4Trauma program, to improve support for survivors of gender-based violence.



We impact from proximity

Family support

- → Inauguration of Azalea, a new work-life balance space for families in Madrid.
- → The Mediacyl Centers of the Regional Government of Castile and León are celebrating their 1st year serving nearly 400 families.
- → **27,035** families in individual, family, group and community care spaces.

Discriminations

- → With the Harmonia Day Center in Terrassa, aimed at cis, trans and non-binary women with difficulties related to substance use. We provide a safe and conducive space for personal development and positive transformation.
- → **14,214** young people in workshops on sexual health, addiction prevention, non-violence. co-education. LGTBQIA+.

Stigmas

- → 5 years of the **Jardí Fènix:** Promoting the employment of people in drug addiction treatment through agroecology.
- → 30th anniversary of **CAMS**: A milestone in supporting people with HIV.
- → In the last year, more than 60 people in treatment and more than 200 people from the metropolitan area have passed through the Jardí Fènix to enjoy the space and community activities.
- → **23,746** energy poverty advice.
- → 7 out of 10 households advised have regularized their supplies.

- **Gender-based** violence and sexual violence in childhood
- → With CRISS CROSS we are running a campaign to promote safer leisure spaces.
- → Through resources such as **Barnahus** Vilanova i la Geltrú and CIASI Madrid we attend to cases of children and adolescents who are victims of sexual violence.
- → **3,918** women and daughters and sons treated as victims of gender-based violence.
- → Through the European Lila project, support has been provided to 103 women survivors of gender-based violence.



Child

- → We are shaping **Meva Energia**, the web app that will advise the citizens of Barcelona on energy consumption.
- → We inaugurate the Ombra space installed with Cooltorise at the Cruyff Camp Jordi Alba.

- → We are expanding the guidance and job support teams at Comunitat Activa.
- → **765** people on personalized social and labor insertion itineraries.
- → Our services have an **80%** success rate of insertion in highly complex groups.
- → **13** people have worked at ABD reconnecting with the labor market thanks to the ESAL Program of the Employment Service of Catalonia (SOC).





With a global reach



- → We launch **Home4Health**, an innovative initiative to tackle homelessness and improve social health in Europe.
- → 20 social inclusion homes.
- → **328** homes with services for the elderly.
- → **590** residents.

- Promoting autonomy and dependence
- → We consolidate a model of care for the elderly based on prevention, community creation and support for individuals and families.
- → **201,531** hours of care in home care services.
- → **1,398** elderly people receive home care services, residences and housing.



- → We incorporate the **Substance Analysis Service** in Supervised Consumption Spaces in Catalonia.
- → We participate in civil society networks such as FCD, UNAD, Correlation, RIOD and NEWNet.
- → **8,172** people in treatment programs for substance dependence.
- → 33,058 people in prevention services for alcohol and other drug consumption.

- Unwanted loneliness and the digital divide among older people
- → Catalonia Impacta Award for ATENEA: Recognized for its AI application that improves care for the elderly.
- → With ATENEA we work to overcome the digital divide and improve the wellbeing of people in vulnerable situations, taking advantage of digital tools to promote inclusion, reduce unwanted loneliness and improve personal safety.
- → **943** elderly people have taken part in community bonding programs and the fight against unwanted loneliness.

- Intellectual disability
- With the Habilitare Torrent Occupational Center we participate in the Self-in project to improve the quality of life and autonomy of people with intellectual functional diversity.
- → **330** people with intellectual disabilities attended to.

Mental health

- → We are part of the Table of the National Mental Health Pact of the Government of Catalonia.
- → We participate in the Study Commission on mental health and addictions of the Parliament of Catalonia.
- → 124 people in mutual support groups or psychological care.

- Community support and volunteering
- → Next Generation's support to give impetus to a new community model of food security ends.
- Volunteering Award for Energy Control: Recognition for damage reduction activities.
- → 495 people trained at the Volunteer School.
- → **15,619** hours of volunteering.

- Migratory movements
- → We attended the opening ceremony of the new Service for Assistance to Immigrants, Emigrants and Refugees SAIER.
